Sutton began her Broadway career winning a Tony Award for Best Actress in a Musical for her starring role as Millie Dillmount in *Thoroughly Modern Millie*, (2002). She has been nominated five times for the Tony, each time in the Outstanding Actress in a Musical category. As of June 2011, she had won twice; in addition to her role in *Thoroughly Modern Millie*, she won for the starring role of Reno Sweeney in Broadway's *Anything Goes*.

Additional nominations were for the roles of Jo March in Broadway's *Little Women* (2005); Janet Van De Graaff in Broadway's *The Drowsy Chaperone* (2006); and Fiona in Broadway's *Shrek The Musical*, (2009).
